Casting - Distributing roles

- **Coaches:**
Listen and give advice
- **Facilitator/Time keeper:**
Guides the group



Steps

- 1) Casting – distributing roles**
- 2) Intention statement by case giver**
- 3) Defining a problem statement or question**
- 4) Consultation from the coach**
- 5) Case giver selects ideas to further work on**
- 6) What is next: formulate 2-3 concrete next steps**
- 7) Feedback and closing**
