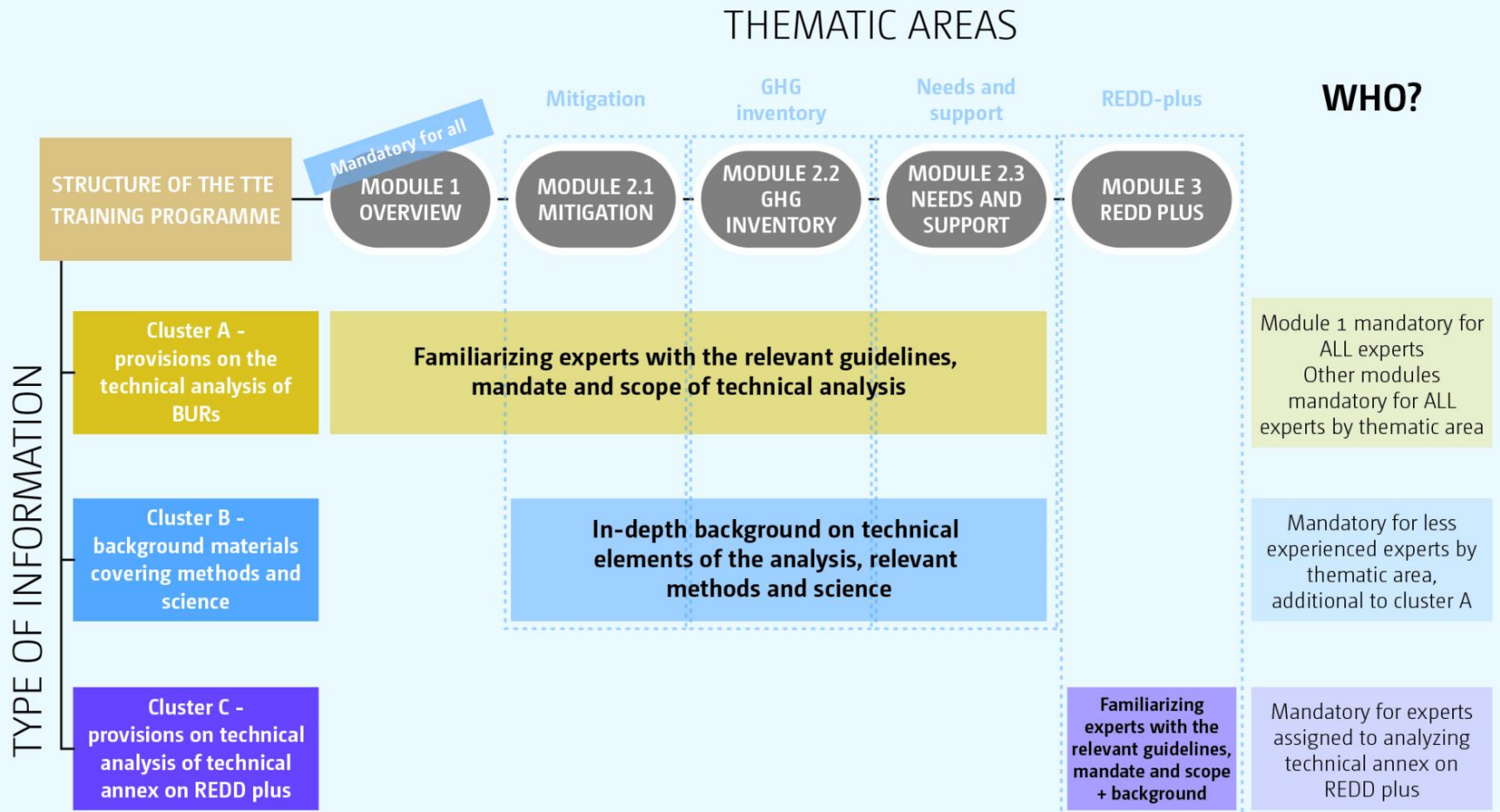
# Programme de formation du GCE

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- COP 19 (Décembre 2013):
  - **Décision 20/CP.19 (para. 4)** demande au **GCE** de **développer et organiser un programme de formation**, basé sur ses derniers matériaux de formation, **pour les experts admis à faire partie de l'équipe d'experts techniques (EET) qui réalise l'analyse technique des rapport bienniaux actualisés (RBA)**.
    - L'objectif principal du programme de formation est de s'assurer que les experts nommés par les points focaux nationaux pour faire partie de la liste des experts **connaissent parfaitement les exigences des rapports des Parties en développement, et les modalités et procédures** du processus de consultations et d'analyses internationales, y compris l'analyse technique des RBA.
    - **Seuls les experts nommés qui ont réussi le programme de formation du GCE sont éligibles pour faire partie des EET.**

## Structure of the TTE training programme

The training programme covers three clusters of training modules:


Find out more about the structure of the training and which modules you need to complete by clicking on the graph.

Some of the experts in the table are highly experienced having participated in a number of previous training rounds. Please, under the Convention, link others (less experienced) have limited experience and expertise. Accordingly, the amount of training required varies.

(A) Provisions on reporting requirements in the ZUs and conducting technical analysis of ZUs to fulfil the measurement, consultation and analysis (CA) process.

(B) Background material covering methods and sources of key themes addressed in ZUs, and

(C) Provisions relevant to the technical analysis of a specific Annex containing information on results-based actions relating to REDD-plus activities.



## Assessments

Assessments will open Open Open Centre European Time (GMT) on the indicated start day and close at Open Centre European Time (GMT) on the indicated end day. Within the assessment period you can start the module in your own discretion.

Once you start a module, you need to complete the module assessment within 60 minutes. The module can be kept open for 60 minutes. To successfully complete a module you need to achieve 80 per cent. Each module is graded individually.

For cluster B, you will immediately see if you have been successful. The training needs to then show as 'Completed and verified from your device'. If you have not been successful, it will remain in your training record and you can directly re-take.

For clusters A and C, in case needed, you will be able to challenge the assessment of a module in the online service benefited on the next round of assessments. All questions Re-takes: 02 Nov - 03 Nov 2016

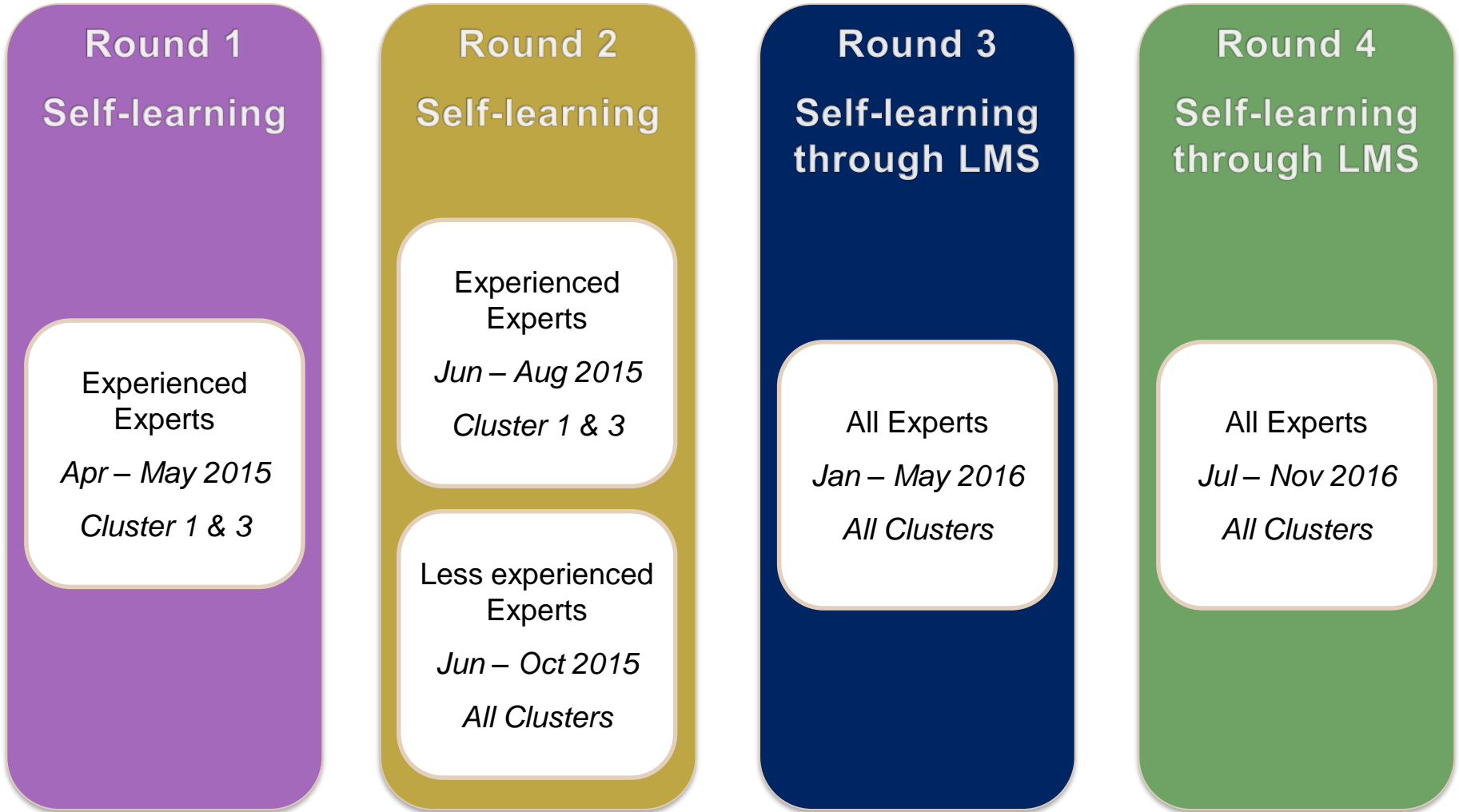

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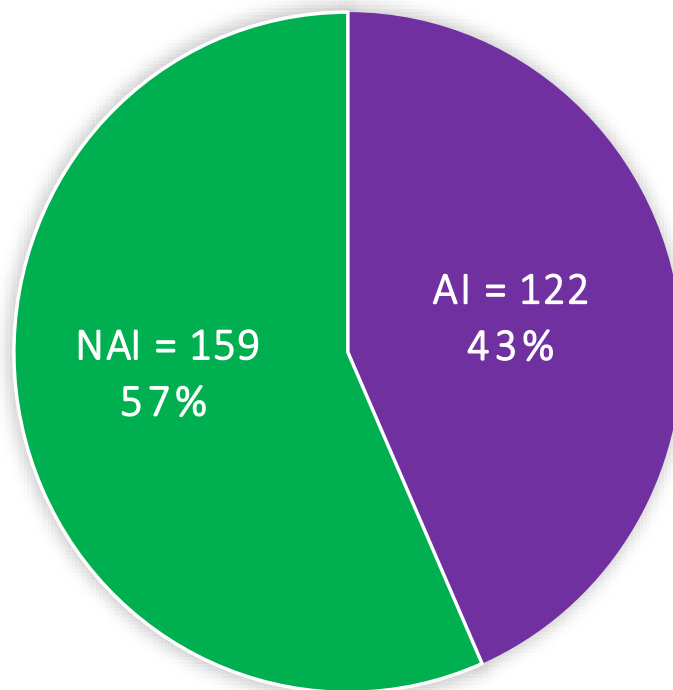

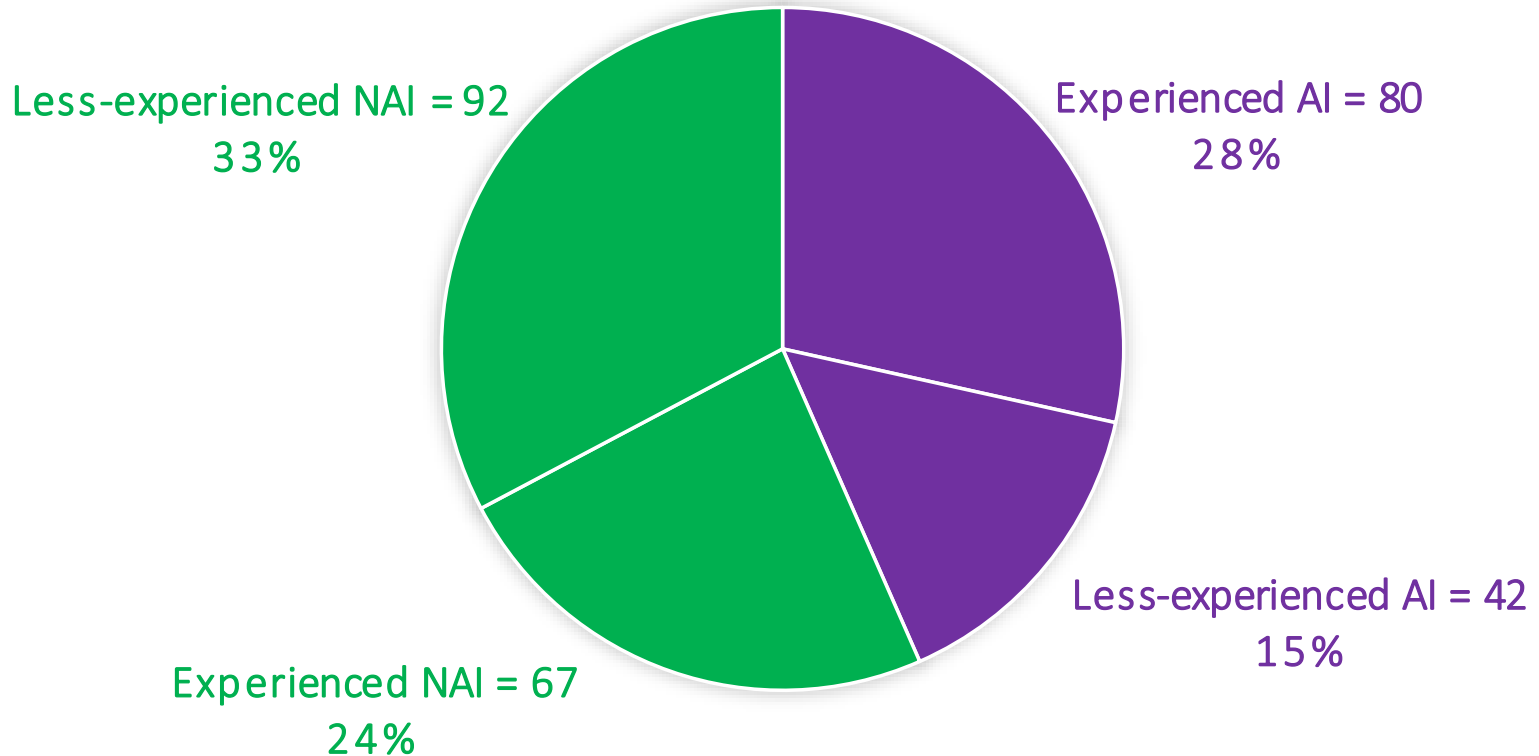
# Statistiques du programme de formation du GCE (2015-2016)

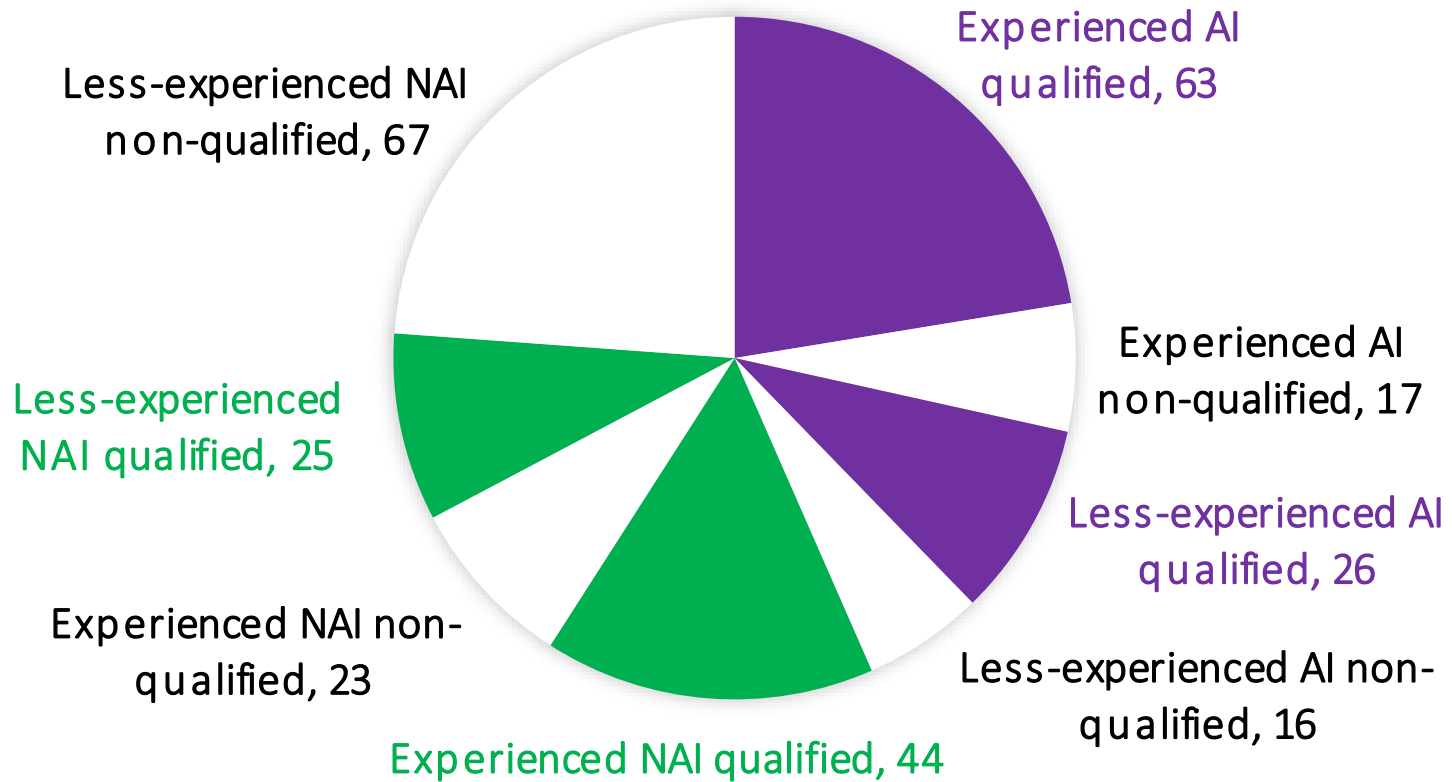
## REGISTRATIONS BY EXPERIENCE



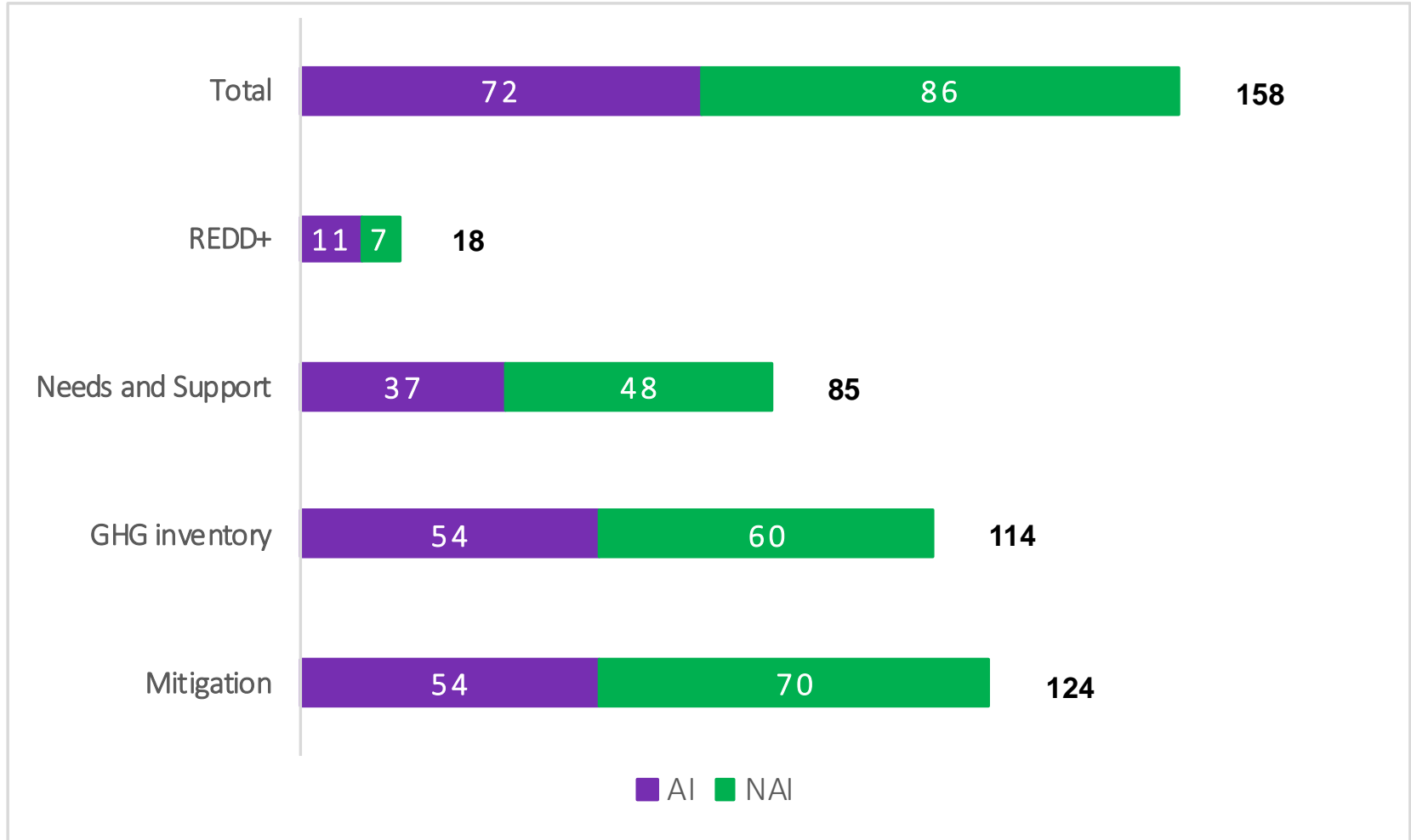

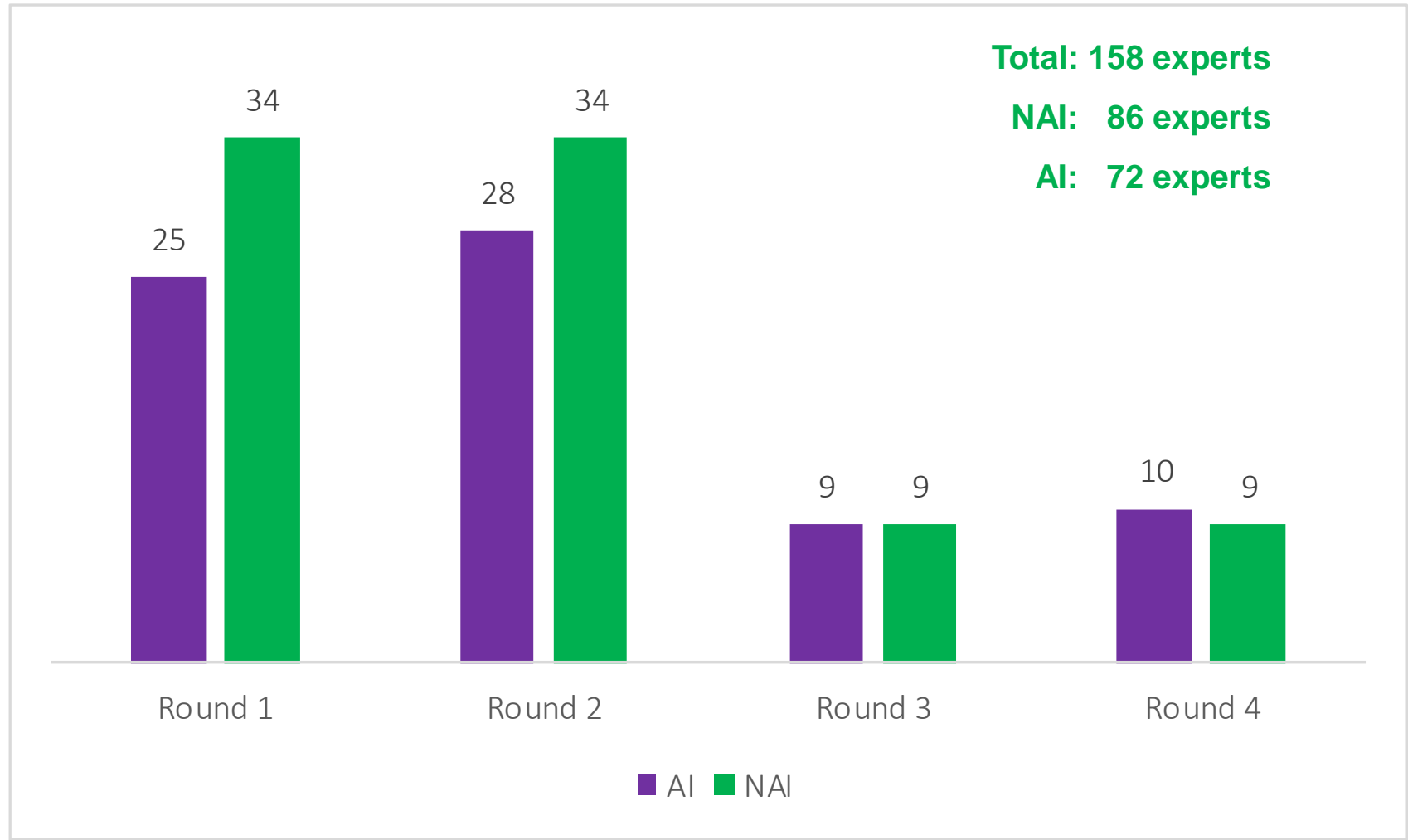
## EXPERTS BY EXPERIENCE & QUALIFICATION = 56%

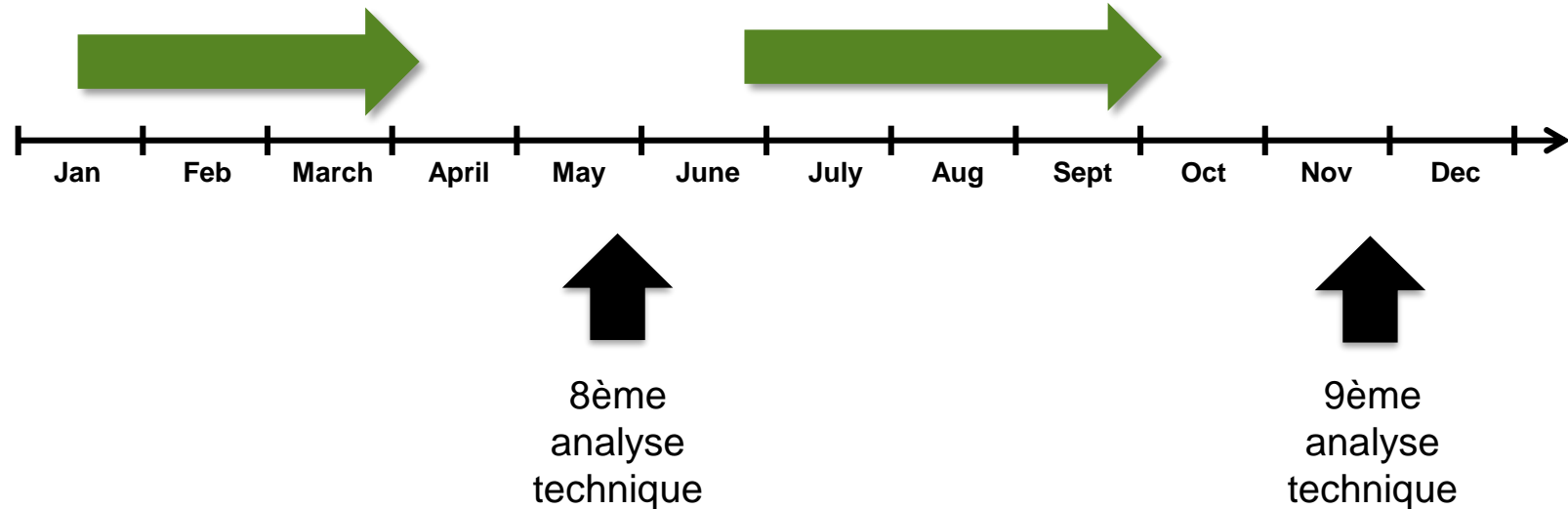

# Formation du Secrétariat aux lignes directrices 2006 du GIEC et aux systèmes de gestion des inventaires de GES



- Mémoire d'accord signé avec le **GIEC** pour une coopération accrue (Janvier 2016)
- Mémoire d'accord signé avec la **FAO** pour une coopération accrue (Mars 2017)
- **Depuis 2016**, un atelier régional de formation est organisé (**Lesotho**, Mars 2016; **Namibie**, Avril 2017) sur les systèmes de gestion des inventaires de GES et l'application des lignes directrices 2006 du GIEC.
- Basé sur l'expérience acquise par le Secrétariat depuis 2007 au cours de 3 projets pilotes de renforcement des capacités (Asie du Sud-Est, Afrique de l'Est et Australe, Afrique de l'Ouest).
- Formation effectuée en partenariat avec le **GIEC** et la **FAO**, avec la collaboration du **GCE**.
