






## The History

## Milestones of the Partnership






#### The Goal

- The Partnership aims at encouraging all countries to step up for enhanced transparency in order to achieve the global goal of keeping temperature increase well below 2° Celsius, and pursuing efforts to limit it to 1.5°Celsius.
- The Partnership seeks to
  - foster transparency, communication, networking and trust between countries;
  - provide capacity building and promote a mutual learning
     process within regions and among practitioners on a global scale
  - identify and disseminate good practices examples and lessons
     learnt








# The Goal 2/2








# **Annual Partnership Retreats 2/2**
