Capacity Building Initiative for Transparency

Decision 1/CP.21 Paris - Paragraph 84

- Decides to establish a Capacity-building Initiative for Transparency (**CBIT**) in order to build **institutional and technical capacity**, both pre- and post-2020
- This initiative will support developing country Parties, upon request, in meeting **enhanced transparency requirements** as defined in Article 13 of the Agreement in a timely manner

CBIT - Objectives

Decision 1/CP21 Paris - Paragraph 84

- a) To strengthen **national institutions** for transparency-related activities in line with national priorities
- b) To provide **relevant tools, training** and **assistance** for meeting the provisions stipulated in Article 13 of the Agreement
- c) To assist in the improvement of **transparency** over time

FAO-GEF CBIT Programme

- AFOLU represents the **2nd major driver of GHG emissions** after energy
 - **Globally accounts for 21% of emissions**, 50% in developing countries
 - One of the **most frequently included** sector in **NDCs**
 - AFOLU related GHG emissions **expected to continue to grow** given increasing global population and food demands

FAO-GEF CBIT Programme

- *Strengthening capacity in the Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land-use (AFOLU) sectors for enhanced transparency and monitoring of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs).*
 - **Global level** *(CEO endorsement October 2018 – 10 pilot countries)*
 - **National level** *(6 PIF already approved – Cambodia, Mongolia, Papua New Guinea, Bangladesh, Cuba and Sri Lanka – and few others in the pipeline under GEF-7)*

FAO-GEF CBIT - *Global*

Objective:

To strengthen developing country technical and institutional capacity, through a coordinated dissemination of knowledge, to meet enhanced transparency framework requirements when implementing priority actions for achieving their respective nationally determined contributions in the Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land Use sector.



FAO-GEF CBIT - *National*

Objective:

By 2020 countries are preparing reports to the UNFCCC under the Paris Agreement Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) with strengthened agriculture and land use sector components including inventories of emissions sources and sinks and information necessary to track progress against priority actions identified in their NDC for these sectors.





FAO-GEF CBIT Global – *Components*

Component 1 **Institutional arrangements** for enhanced transparency

Component 2 **Transparency** for measuring, reporting and verifying
(MRV) **mitigation** actions and monitoring and evaluating
(M&E) **adaptation** progress

Component 3 **Global knowledge sharing** and coordination amongst
transparency practitioners



FAO-GEF CBIT Global – *Main Outputs*

- A set of stand-alone tools (i.e. **Global Products**)
 - Review and synthesis of existing MRV and M&E tools, methodologies and best practices and
 - New set of global tools, methodologies and best practices to adequately respond to the 2006 IPCC guidelines and adhere to the ETF requirements.
 - **Country-level work** creating a feedback loop that will serve to improve the Global Products and extend their global outreach
 - **Dissemination** and **coordination**

FAO-GEF CBIT Global – *Status*

- CEO endorsement in October 2018 and **operational in January 2019**
 - **20 pilot candidate countries** have been identified based on:
 - NDC AFOLU content
 - AFOLU GHG emissions
 - Institutional and technical capacity
 - Partnerships/Networks
 - 10 pilot countries will be selected based on a **participatory approach**

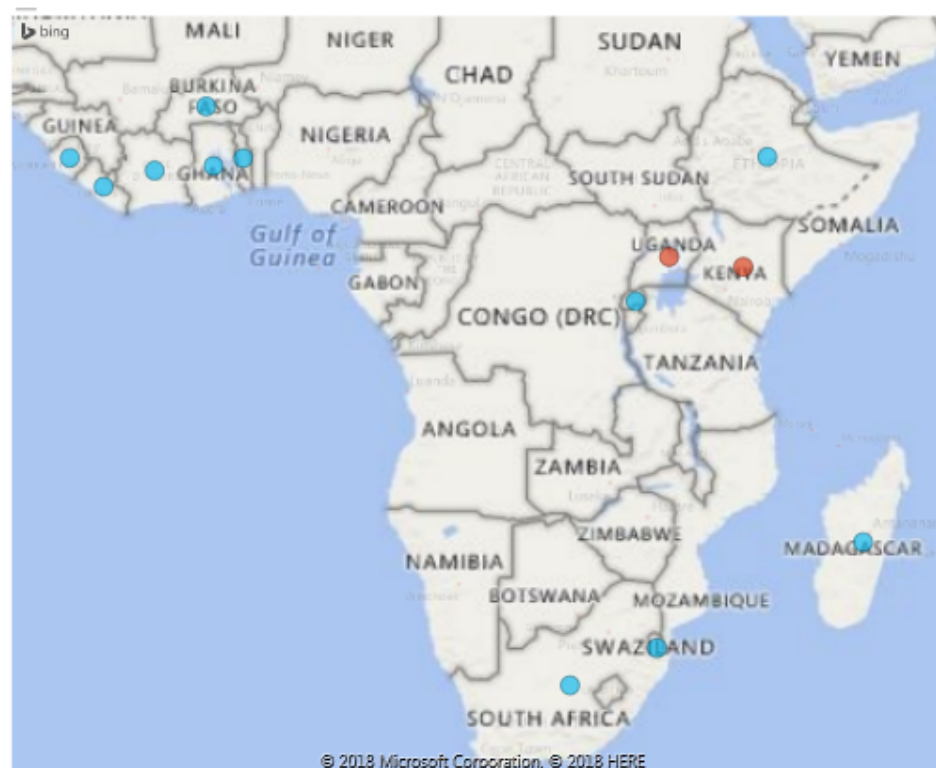

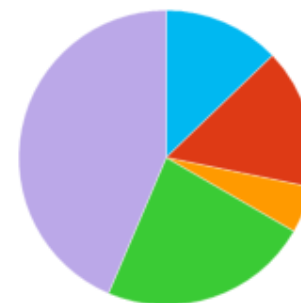
