UNFCCC Focus of MRV of support received (1)

Reporting guidelines on **support provided by Annex II countries**:

- Quantified information on:
 - Bilateral, regional financial flows (mitigation and adaptation)
 - Contributions to multilateral agencies, GEF
 - Technology transfer, “where feasible”
- Qualitative information on capacity building
- ▶ Annex II countries need to improve on reporting formats (e.g. incoherent use of reporting years and periods; reporting guidelines) to close information gaps

UNFCCC Focus of MRV of support received (2)

Non-Annex I countries

- “should” provide information on
 - register, monitor & report on **support (finance, technology transfer and capacity building) received**
 - Support needed
- “improving reporting systems” by using more complete climate finance reporting guidelines

(Robust) MRV of climate support

Assess the support objectives and facilitate the implementation of these objectives.

- **Transparency** on how much climate support is flowing to developing countries; extend of support from developed countries and how is the support used
- **Accountability** about how parties are progressing in delivering their obligations outlined in the Cancún Agreement
- Facilitates learning and boost **effectiveness & efficiency** of support programmes by ensuring support
