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## Objective of the exercise

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- The exercise shall highlight the basic criteria that could be used for NAMA selection, but also their potential diverse perception and valuation from different stakeholders
- **Settings:**
- 5 Groups representing different Ministries and one NGO in state of “**LowerCarbonia**”,
  - a fast advancing developing country with a rapidly changing economy and industry
  - also a poorer region with limited access to electricity / modern transportation etc.
  - Substantial wind and solar power potential on the coast (higher cost than those of coal power currently dominating electricity supply)
  - frequent power outages due to an electricity demand surplus
  - electricity and fuel prices are subsidized.

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## Groups

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- **Group 1:** Ministry of Electricity (representing the power sector and utilities)
- **Group 2:** Ministry of Transport (representing the transport sector)
- **Group 3:** Ministry of Economics (representing the industrial sector)
- **Group 4:** Ministry of Environment (DNA/NAMA coordinator/UNFCCC communication)
- **Group 5:** National Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) called EMPONGO - “Empowering NGO” in “LowerCarbonia”
