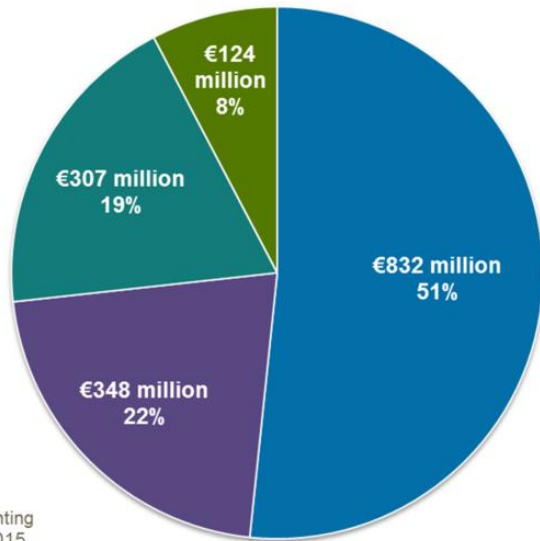


The International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German Federal Environment Ministry (BMUB)

- Since 2008 financing **climate and biodiversity projects** in developing and newly industrialising countries, as well as in countries in transition.
- Key element of Germany's climate financing. Projects **implement decision of UNFCCC negotiations**.
- **Supports global transformation** process to lead economies on low emissions and climate resilient development paths.
- Supports countries to **develop and implement NDCs as well as pre-2020 measures and long-term plans**.
- Strengthens **capacities and methods for management and measurement** of national activities to coordinate transformation.



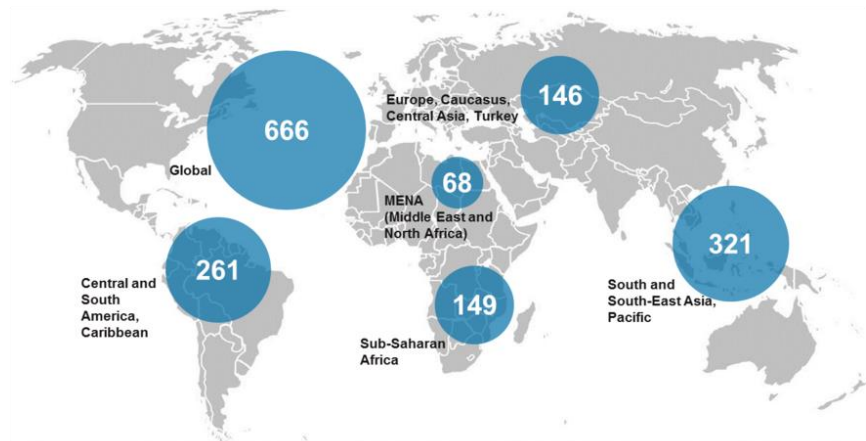
IKI Projects by Topic and Region

- **IKI NDC Support Cluster** to ensure coordinated and comprehensive NDC implementation support within the IKI.
- Ongoing and additional support through bi- and multilateral IKI projects.
- Targeted support in **four thematic areas**:
 - Political and institutional landscape,
 - Sector approaches,
 - Financing,
 - Data and Transparency.
- **Comprehensive support package**, bundling the expertise of various organisations in the field of NDC implementation.
- Contribution to the **discussion on NDC implementation at the international level**.



Strengthening the focus on NDC implementation support within the IKI

- **Mainstreaming NDC implementation** into the overall portfolio of the IKI
- **Extending the scope of the IKI NDC Support Cluster** as reflected in the funding information on the selection procedure 2017 for the funding areas mitigation, adaptation and REDD+:

Particular attention is paid in the selection process to relevance to the implementation of NDCs and the corresponding priority-setting by the partner countries.

Amended Call procedures include:



- Simplified application procedures
- Enhanced appraisal phase (Detailed Preparation Phase, DPP) to strengthen readiness for implementation of projects



Submission deadline for projects: 31 October 2016

Projects must have implementation period of 3-5 yrs and budget of EUR 5-20m
