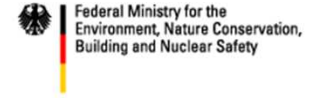

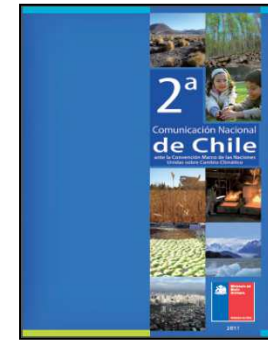

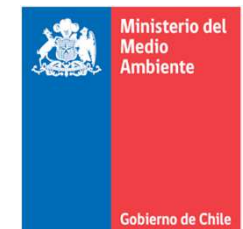

- 3 BURs

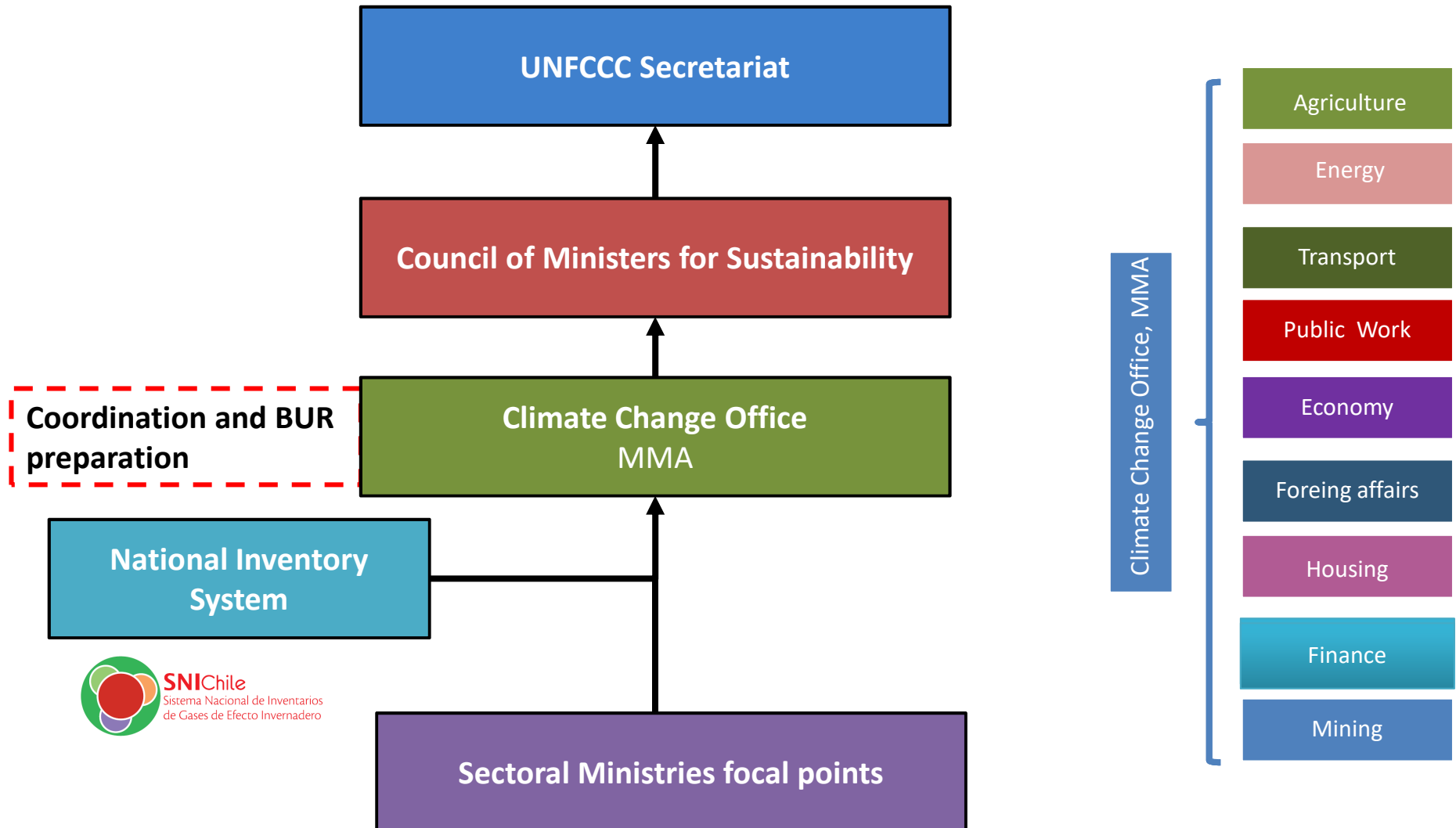


All 3 BURs have been submitted on time and have built a permanent mechanism of domestic reporting on a yet voluntary basis

## Institutional Arrangement for international report elaboration



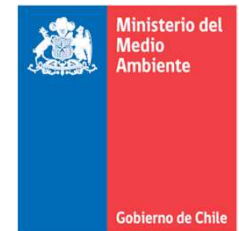
# National benefits of a robust transparency system

## General:

- Political Buy –in
- The exchange of information with private sector has improved
- Improvement of country international image
- Countries are prepared for new requirements of information under international agreements

## Specific:

- Better analysis of public policies implementation
- Improvement of cooperation among different sectors and institutions
- Improvement of other national statistics or environmental reporting



## Challenges and Support needed to deal with ETF requirements

- Current ICA process can help countries to identify needed enhanced capacity needs to elaborate BTR in the future
- MPGs present enough flexibility to countries to implement them gradually as they improve capacities
- New aspects of the BTR will require specific training, such as projections
- Collaboration initiatives such as the REDINGEI in Latin America has been preparing countries to implement some of the new requirements, so this should be replicated for other items
