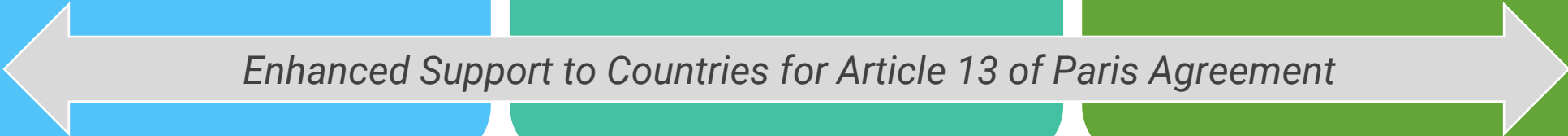

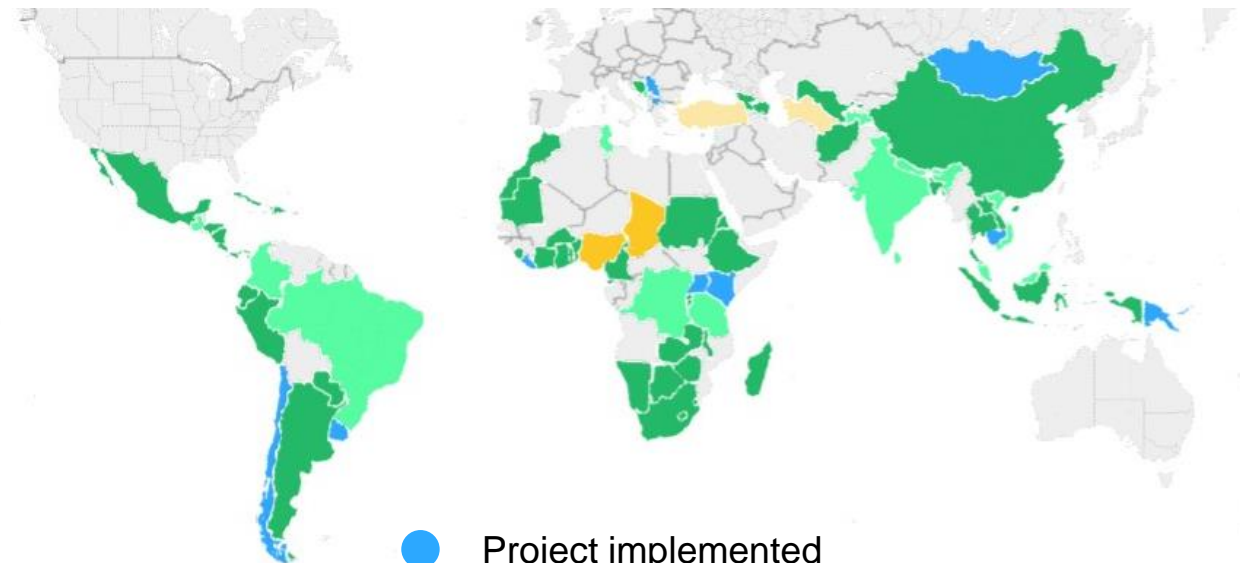
# CBIT portfolio overview

## Growing, balanced portfolio

- 93 projects in 88 countries, which accounts for \$155.2 million
- 85 National Projects
- 34 countries in Africa, 22 in LAC, 19 in Asia and 9 in ECA
- 7 Agencies: CI, FAO, FECO, IDB, UNEP, UNDP, and WWF-US

## Distribution of CBIT Portfolio by project status

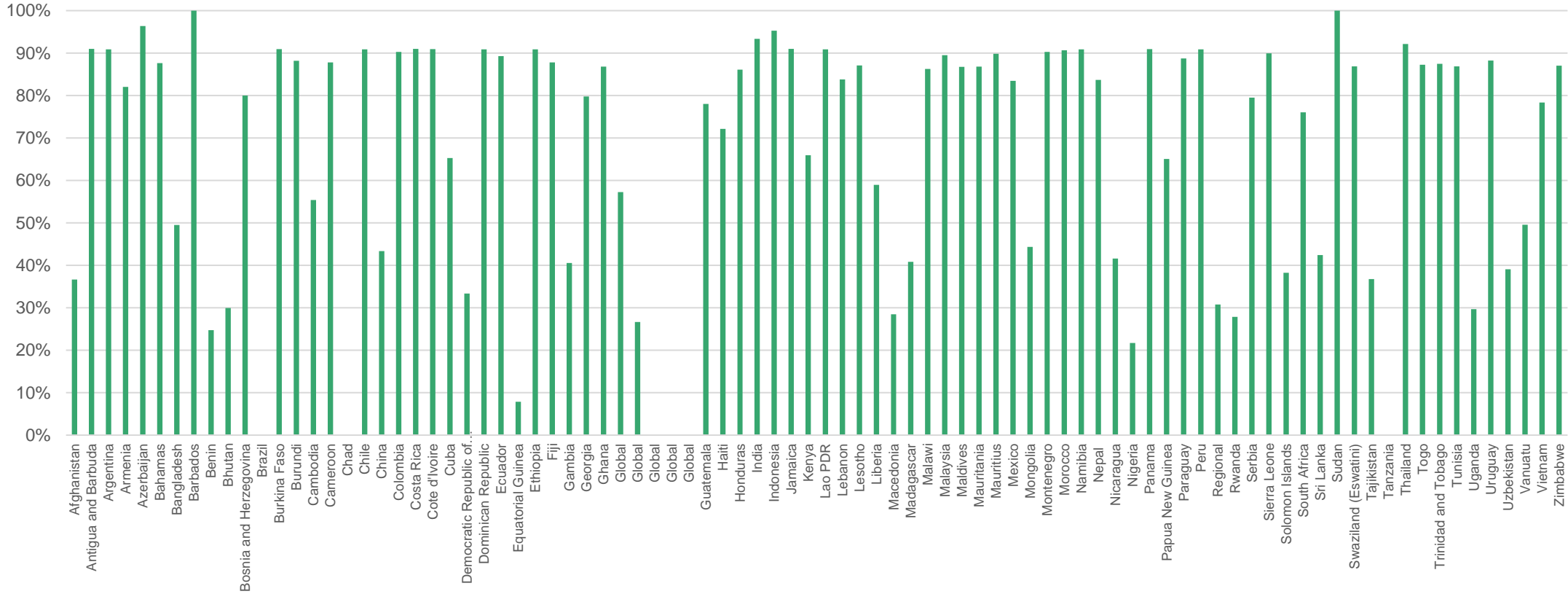

## Funding for Reporting Systems elements as percentage of GEF Project Grant (%)

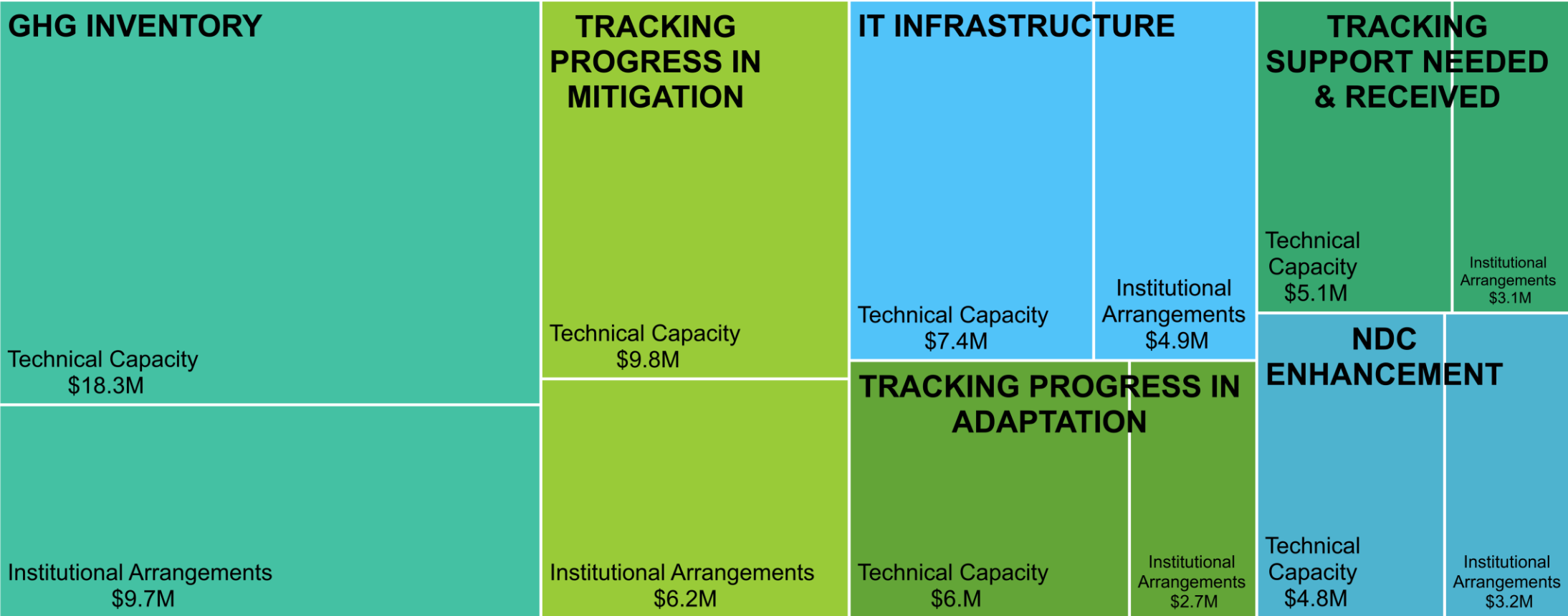

Distribution of reporting system elements (USD)

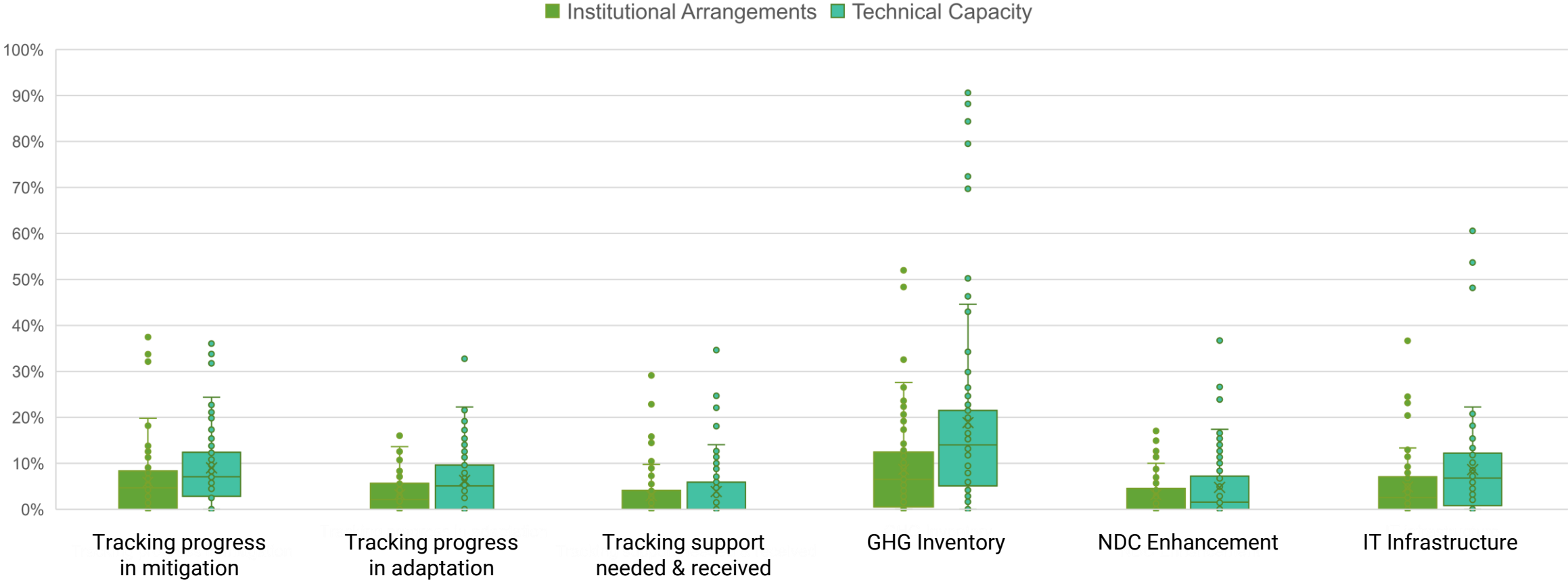

## Reporting system elements (box plot)

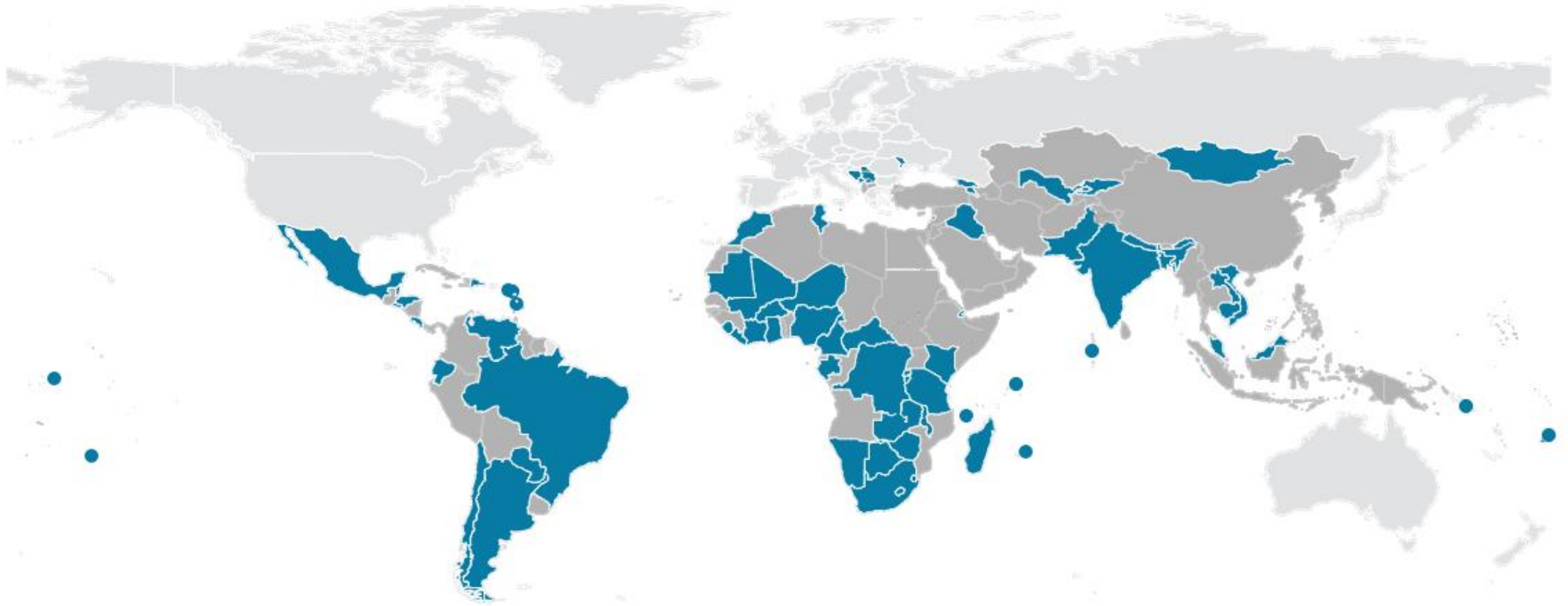

# Overview of GEF Support to BTR

Information note [GEF/C.62/Inf.15](#) updated the indicative costing of BTRs as follows:

Stand-alone BTR	Combined BTR/NC	Additional financing (top-up)
Up to \$600,000 from set-aside funding	Up to \$633,000 from set-aside funding	Up to \$250,000 from set-aside funding
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Available since January 2021</li><li>• Country must not have ongoing BUR support</li><li>• Ongoing NC is acceptable</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Available since January 2021</li><li>• Country must not have ongoing NC or BUR support</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Available for countries that, as of January 1, 2023, have an ongoing BUR or NC</li><li>• This option is only intended to be used for the first BTR</li></ul>

\* Updates to BTR costing are effective from July 1, 2022, onwards.

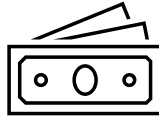

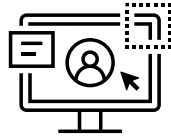

# ETF support under the GEF8 (2022-2026)

---



**Increased resources.** \$145 million in GEF-8  
(up from \$110 million in GEF-7)



**Updated cost structure.** Indicative cost structure of BTRs updated from July 1, 2022 ([Information note GEF/C.62/Inf.15](#))



**Bundled Reports.** Countries can access two BTRs and one NC (as applicable) as part of the same enabling activity project



**Growing demand.** Growing demand for BTRs towards 2024 deadline



**Synergies.** Explore interlinkages and align BTR and CBIT projects
