Final BRs by 31 Dec. 2022

Developing countries:
Final BUR by 31 Dec. 2024

All Parties:
*First biennial transparency reports (**BTRs**) by 31 Dec. 2024 (SIDS and LDCs have discretion)*

All Parties:
National communications (may be joined with BTR)

Developed country Parties
Also Annual GHG inventories

*BR: Biennial Report
BUR: Biennial Update Report*

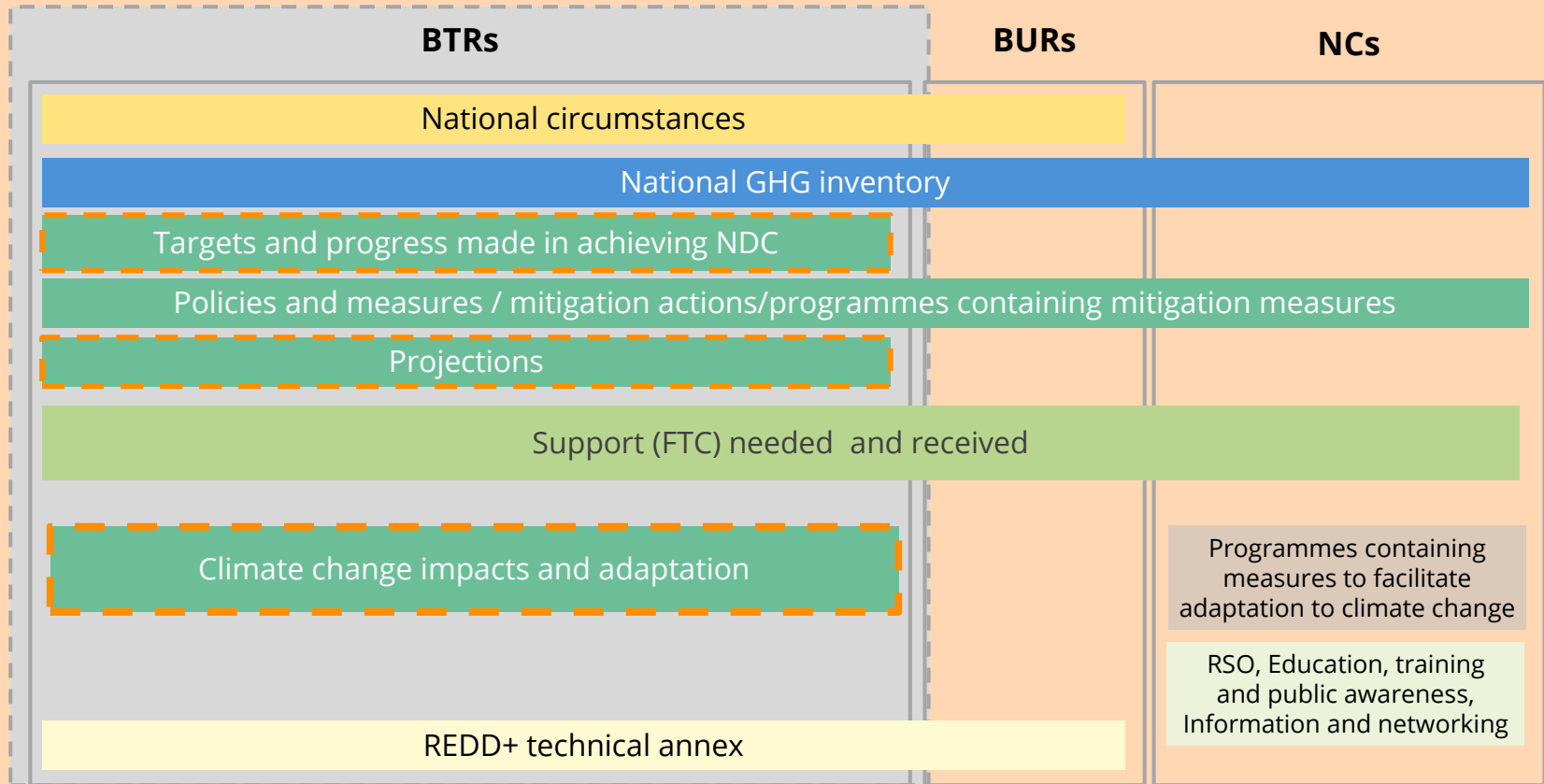

Enhancement of reporting - developing countries

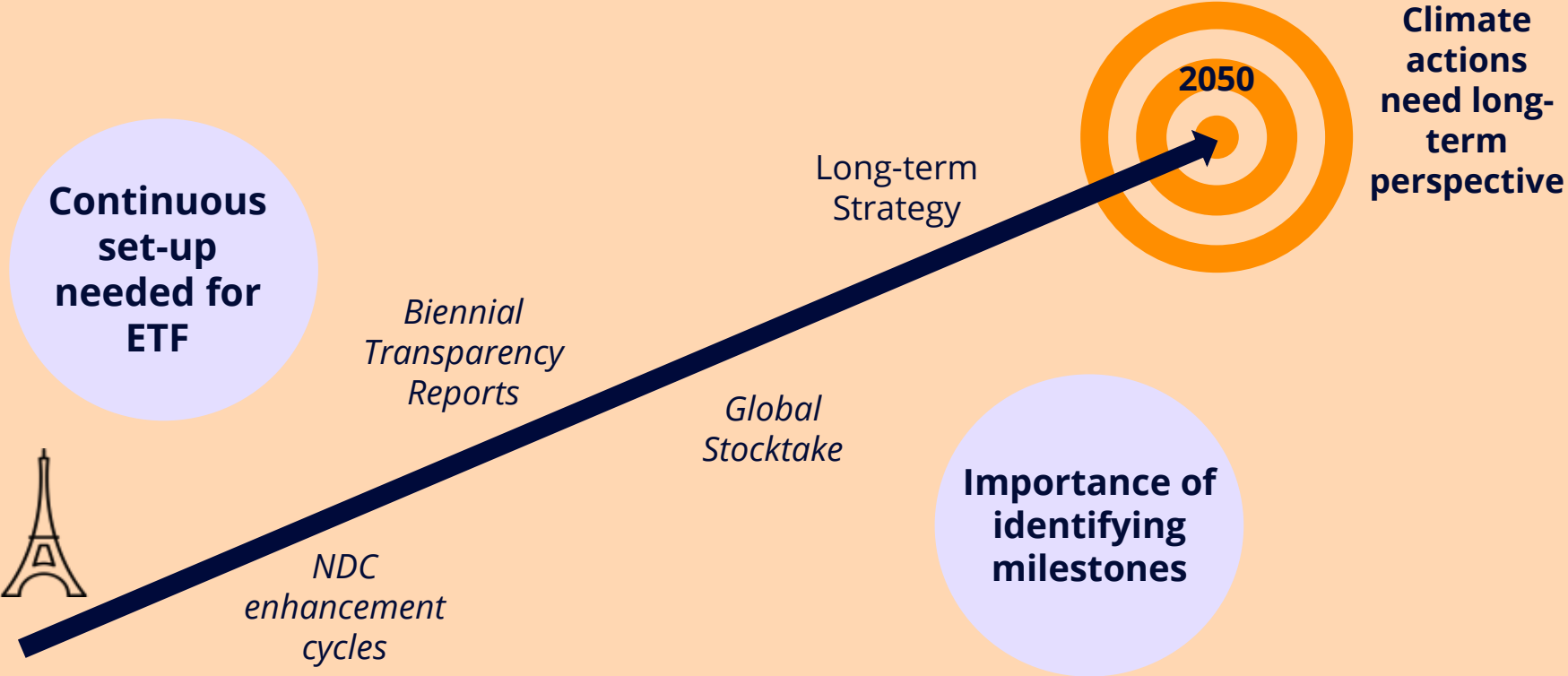


New elements for developing countries

Key aspects of the Enhanced Transparency Framework

- Builds on **existing MRV arrangements** under the Convention
- One set of modalities, procedures and guidelines (MPGs) **applicable to all Parties**
- Provides **flexibility** to those developing country Parties that needs it in the light of their capacities
- Recognizes the importance of **support to developing country Parties**

Planning for a transparency framework is crucial

Plan resources for ETF

1 **Improve** existing data flows

2 **Engage** national actors, e.g. statistics offices

3 **Develop** data management & archiving systems

4 **Plan** for trainings & capacity building

5 **Mobilize** support for infrastructure & cover operational needs

Transparency: turn an **obligation** into an **opportunity**

- Data to design **evidence-based** actions and policies
- Link to impact on **national priorities** (NDC implementation, climate policies, adaptation, sustainable development)
- Engage the **stakeholders** needed for data collection & analysis
- Facilitate the **mobilization of finance**
- **Time is short:** start now and build on what is there
