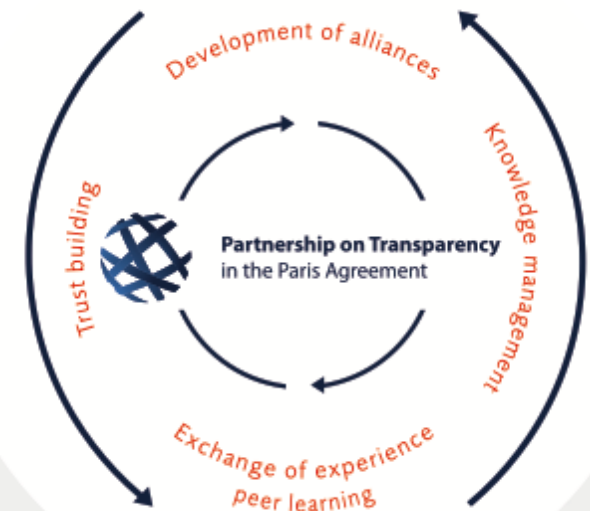


The Partnership's Goal

The Partnership seeks to

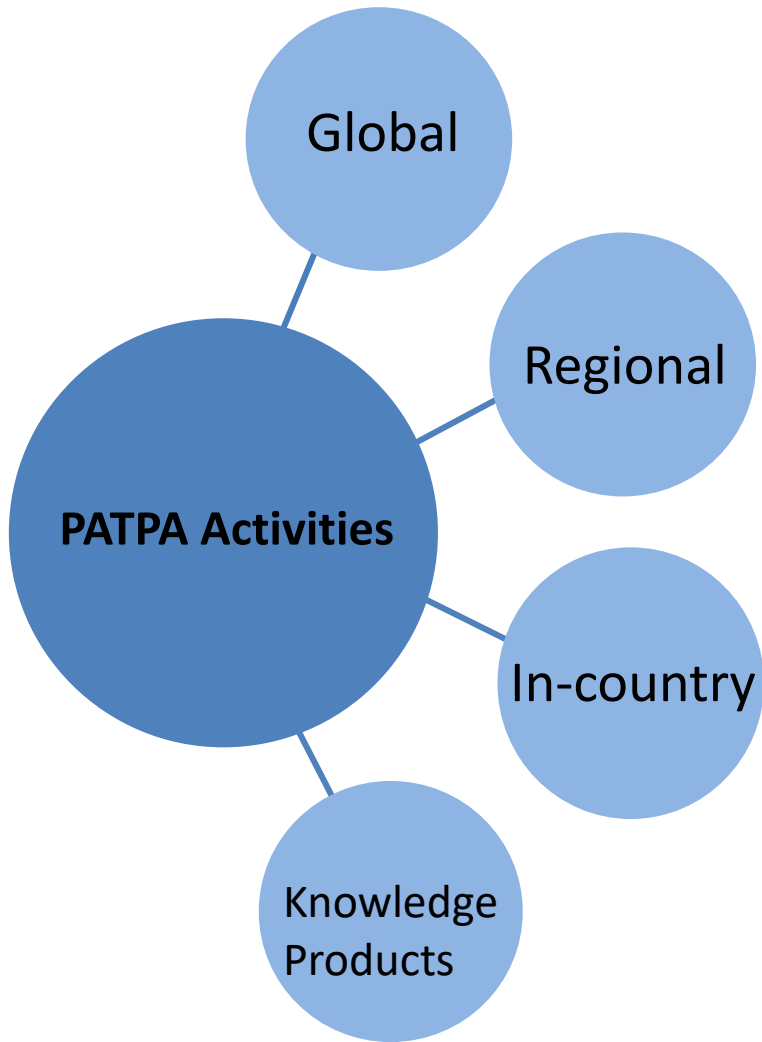
- support successful **negotiations on transparency** by fostering **dialogue** and **trust** between countries;
