The **Partnership on Transparency in the Paris Agreement** (formerly: International Partnership on Mitigation & MRV) was **launched in May 2010** at the Petersberg Climate Dialogue by **South Africa, Republic of Korea and Germany**.



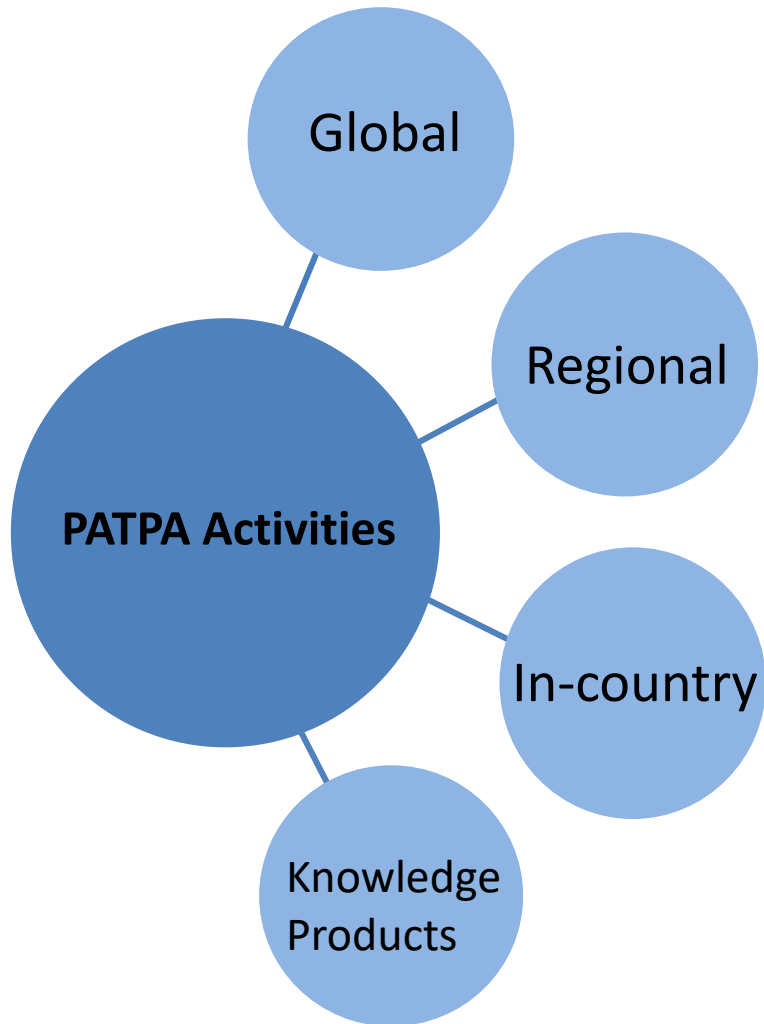


The Partnership's Goal

- support successful **negotiations on transparency** by fostering **dialogue** and **trust** between countries;
- promote the **implementation of the ETF** through providing demand-driven **capacity building** and enabling **mutual learning** in South-South-North exchange formats;
- identify and disseminate **good practices** and **lessons learnt**, incl. through the publication of knowledge products.
