













## First Cross-Regional Technical Workshop of the Lusophone Cluster and the Francophone Network

NDC Tracking for mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation

17-20 October 2023, Hotel Sheraton Levent, Istanbul, Türkiye

<u>General Objective</u>: To promote the best implementation of the decisions linked to the Paris Agreement Rulebook, in particular those adopted on NDC tracking and all critical aspects related to mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation.

## Specific Objectives:

- Analyzing gaps, lessons learnt, sharing best practices, and utilizing available tools for monitoring and reporting NDC implementation in the countries of the Lusophone Cluster and the Francophone Network.
- Providing technical training to leaders in national institutions to identify opportunities, challenges, risks, and benefits associated with implementing the Paris Agreement Rulebook, particularly regarding NDC tracking.
- Facilitating discussions on the requirements outlined in the ICTU Annex of the second NDCs (Annex 1 to decision 4/CMA.1).
- Identifying common challenges in aligning NDCs with national development agendas and fostering collaboration among country teams on NDCs' mitigation, adaptation, and means of implementation, tracking and reporting.
- Offering information to national participants about potential sources of support to strengthen their institutions in addressing NDC tracking challenges.

<u>Language</u>: for the joint sessions of the workshop, professional interpretation will be provided in English, French and Portuguese to all participants. For the separate sessions, the workshop will be in each respective language of the regional group i.e., French or Portuguese, and no interpretation will be provided.
